



As we look to regather on campus for small group Bible studies and worship services in the near future, we are introducing added safety precautions and would ask for our members to support and observe these to the best of their ability for the good of all. We want our church family of friends to proceed with caution and compassion as we ***Trust in God*** to lead, guide, and direct us in the days and months ahead.

- Worship service and Bible study times will be adjusted to allow more time in between for safer entrance, exiting, and cleaning. The new service/group times will be **8:00, 9:30 & 11:00 a.m.**
- Attendees will be asked to wear masks if possible; we will have some available if needed.
- Doors will open for entrance into the Worship Center or classrooms 15 minutes prior to start.
- One-way traffic flow (entry only/exit only) will be encouraged through doors and hallways.
- Additional hand sanitizing stations will be placed at various locations around our campus.
- Overall seating capacity will be reduced, and chairs will be set up in the Worship Center and in classrooms to encourage and maintain appropriate social distances. (Please do not rearrange.)
- Attendees will be encouraged to avoid shaking hands and refrain from any additional unnecessary physical contact while on campus.
- Some Adult Connect Groups (mostly those not bringing children) will resume meeting on campus, while others (mostly those with children) are encouraged to continue meeting together online.
- We will encourage children to sit with their parents in worship; however, there will NOT be any childcare, nor children's programming (Infants-8th grade) on Sundays until further notice. They will NOT be allowed to attend Adult Connect Groups with their parents on campus either.
- High School Students (9th-12th grade) will resume meeting on campus, but on Sunday evenings.
- Please DO NOT attend if you or someone in your family is sick or has been running a fever recently.
- Vulnerable people or those who are at-risk should continue to utilize our online groups/services.
- In the foreseeable future, NO food or beverages will be served on campus.

We will be offering on campus worship services that are family friendly. **Registration is required each week** to ensure we do not exceed the maximum capacity recommended by local officials. We are encouraging people over 60 years of age to consider attending the early service if possible. Please register to attend one of these services on our church website. **Registration is on a first come, first served basis**, and will close once maximum capacities are reached.
