- Doors will open for entrance into the Worship Center or classrooms 15 minutes prior to start.
- One-way traffic flow (entry only/exit only) will be encouraged through doors and hallways.
- Additional hand sanitizing stations will be placed at various locations around our campus.
- Overall seating capacity will be reduced, and chairs will be set up in the Worship Center and in classrooms to encourage and maintain appropriate social distances. (Please do not rearrange.)
- Attendees will be encouraged to avoid shaking hands and refrain from any additional unnecessary physical contact while on campus.
- Please **DO NOT** attend if you or someone in your family is sick or has been running a fever recently.
- Vulnerable people or those who are at-risk should continue to utilize our online groups/services.
- We are encouraging people over 60 years of age to consider attending the early service if possible.
